Pit to Port.net to be installed throughout Anglo Coal Australia

QMASTOR Limited (ASX: QML)-Australia's leading supplier of bulk materials management information systems - announced today that it has secured a 5-year contract with Anglo Coal Australia (ACA) for the provision and ongoing support of QMASTOR's Pit to Port .net product as ACA's Marketing and Logistics System (AMS).
