

# QMASTOR bags SLN order



Australian bulk materials management information systems supplier, QMASTOR is to provide its Pit to Port.net supply chain management system to Societe Le Nickel (SLN) in New Caledonia.

Under the agreement, QMASTOR will provide SLN with a comprehensive supply chain solution through the use of its Pit to Port.net and dPipe software products. SLN's New Caledonian operations include five main mining centres and associated load ports, as well as a discharge port and the world's largest ferro-nickel smelter in Noumea.

Pit to Port.net will be implemented to provide detailed material tracking, inventory and stockpile management, blending and grade control, and comprehensive reporting. dPipe will facilitate seamless integration to internal system for automated data interchange.

QMASTOR has also se-

cured a contract with OneSteel for the provision of the Pit to Port.net system at the Whyalla Steelworks as part of Project Magnet.

QMASTOR will provide OneSteel Whyalla with an end-to-end supply chain solution, which will be used by both OneSteel and its mining and logistics contractors. OneSteel is a major manufacturer of steel long products and is the leading metals distribution company in Australia

Project Magnet is a A\$325M project that will commercialise OneSteel's magnetite iron ore resource and upgrade the Whyalla Steelworks. The project is expected to extend mine life to at least 2027.
